Public Information Request

The Port of Columbia will make available for inspection and/or photocopying all public records unless exempt from disclosure under section 42.56 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW).

Charges: There is no charge for reviewing documents or files at the Port office, and there is no charge to receive documents via email already on file electronically - However \$.05 per side is charged for scanning any document, \$.15 per side is charged for photocopying letter and legal size documents and \$.25 per side is charged for color and 11"x17" copies. If you request that records be mailed to you, the actual envelope and postage cost will also be incurred.

Hours: Public records are available for inspection at the Port office Monday - Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (excluding legal holidays). An appointment with a 48 hour minimum notice is required.

The Port reserves the right to determine that a requested public record is exempt from disclosure under the provisions of RCW § 42.56. In addition, the Port reserves the right to delete identifying details when, by making said public records available, there could be an invasion of personal privacy protected by RCW § 42.56.
